Procedures using the MiniLap® Instruments require fewer trocars and cause less trauma to the patient than traditional laparoscopic procedures.

The asymmetrically dilating Weck Vista® Optical Trocar features excellent light transmission through its transparent tip that enables clear visualization of tissue layers during entry. It incorporates ridges on the cannula providing excellent port stability particularly throughout extended procedures.

Teleflex's newest addition – the Weck® EFx Shield® Fascial Closure System – is the only shielded port closure device, providing enhanced sharps protection for safe, uniform, and consistent fascial closure.
