

Robins AFB 128 MWac Solar Project

Project Overview

- Georgia Power (GPC) built, owns, operates and maintains the 128 MWac /175 MWdc solar facility on approximately 650-acres of land located in Bibb County, GA.
- The Central Georgia Joint Development Authority (CGJDA) executed a long term land lease with GPC for use of the land.
- The project provided upgrades to the area electrical network resulting in greater area operating flexibility and reliability as well as enhanced resiliency to Robins AFB.
- All energy flows to the grid for GPC retail customers.
- Georgia Power selected Signal Energy as the Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC) contractor to design and build the project.

- Provides area electrical network improvements
- Enhances operational capacity, flexability and regional energy reliability
- Provides greater operating flexibility
- Strengthens the energy resiliency at Robins AFB
- Provides additional fuel diversity for Georgians
- Represents a significant investment to support a Georgia military base
- · Contributes significant tax revenues to the middle Georgia area
