<sup>4</sup> Edison Electric Institute (EEI) transfers a portion of the Company's dues to other trade groups who, in turn, use a portion of those transferred dues in their lobbying efforts. In 2025, EEI transferred a portion of the Company's dues to the Utility Solid Waste Activities Group and \$1,450 of those transferred dues were used for lobbying.
