New Robotics Capabilities Available at Advanced Surgery Center of Sarasota

In May, the facility performed its first case using the Stryker Mako SmartRobotics, which offers total knee arthroplasty, partial knee arthroplasty and total hip arthroplasty. Mako SmartRobotics combines 3D CT-based planning, AccuStop haptic technology and data analytics into one platform.

Using the Mako system, physicians can access 3D images of a patient's unique anatomy to create a treatment plan and assess and balance the joint.
